- The Twenty Fourth Edition of the Frequency List No. 2 containing the list of facilities operating or plan to operate on frequencies in the band 108-117.975 MHz and 960-1215 MHz; and
- The Twenty Third Edition of the Frequency List No.3 containing the list of facilities operating or plan to operate on frequencies in the band 117.975-137.000 MHz.
